Advisory Council Membership

 - Worksite tour
 - Informational Interviews

- If a business, a commitment to hosting at least one intern yearly
- Attendance at all Pathway Reviews - these are quarterly meetings for Advisory Council members to review STEAM Center curriculum and student work
- Participate in annual survey

Advisory Council members will receive public recognition on the STEAM Center website, in STEAM publications, and in the STEAM Center at Building 77 in the Brooklyn Navy Yard.
