

What is IB professional development?

IB professional development workshops and resources are essential tools to develop both educators and school programmes, however far along a school is on its authorization journey. With multiple modalities and offerings available, IB professional development offers flexibility, affordability, and opportunities for collaboration across school communities.

What are the options for professional development?

Scheduled PD

We set a schedule of professional development offerings that are open for educators to register and attend.

Regional events are scheduled face-to-face training events that are organized to meet the training needs of educators throughout the global IB community. They are open for mass participation and take place in a variety of locations according to market needs (including hotels, conference centres, universities, schools). Regional events are delivered by the IB or one of our official providers.

Online workshop events provide educators with the opportunity to experience the same learning outcomes as face-to-face workshops, but with added flexibility where participants do not need to take time out of school. The workshop is an asynchronous online course with at least one opportunity for live (synchronous) engagement. Participants are a part of a global cohort for the workshop. One event is held monthly with a variety of workshop sessions scheduled.

Regional Virtual events provide the opportunity for educators to take part in the same scheduled training usually on offer at our face-to-face IB regional events, without the need to travel or physically attend sessions at a designated venue. Workshops at virtual regional events will be delivered live within a dedicated virtual classroom. Regional virtual events are delivered by the IB or one of our official providers.

Requested PD

Schools can request an event to meet their professional learning needs. These events support schools in meeting authorization and evaluation requirements, and provide a collaborative environment for teachers and staff, while eliminating or greatly reducing participant travel costs.

Single-School events are school requested IB PD events that consist of one or more workshops organized to meet one school's professional development needs. These events can be delivered according to one of the four modes of delivery listed below.

Multi-school events are school requested IB PD events that consist of one or more workshops organized to meet the professional development needs of two or more schools located within close proximity to one another. These events can be delivered according to one of the four modalities listed below.

Modes of delivery:

Face to face workshops are delivered in person at a school location or at an external venue chosen by the requesting school, subject to IB approval.

Online workshops provide educators with an exclusive online workshop offering for their own school. These workshops delivered to one school cohort allow closer interaction with online facilitators and therefore offer a more school-specific experience. Online by request achieves the same learning outcomes as our scheduled online events, with workshops led by an approved Online Facilitator.

Virtual workshops allow schools to engage in synchronous learning through a dedicated online platform or ‘virtual classroom’, without the need to attend training at a school facility. Within the virtual classroom, participants engage with the same content and achieve the same learning outcomes as our face-to-face events, led by an approved IB Workshop Leader in a format optimised for virtual delivery.

Blended workshops combine face-to-face and remote learning approaches (currently available only in the Americas region) and minimize time away from school. This delivery option consists of three hours asynchronous online learning alongside a two-day face-to-face event.
