

Internationals Network strives to provide quality education for recently-arrived immigrants by sustaining a strong network of innovative Internationals schools and academies. As the only school development and support organization dedicated to the needs of new immigrants and refugees, Internationals has become a leading national voice in the fight for educational equity. Our network, once rooted in four small schools in NYC, now serves over 5,000 students in NYC and has grown to a national network of 30 programs serving nearly 10,000 immigrant and refugee youth. Our NYC network consists of 16 schools (15 high schools and 1 middle school) located in the Bronx (6 high schools and 1 middle school), Brooklyn (3), Manhattan (2), and Queens (4).

Internationals provides a variety of supports to its expansive network through school-based and network partnerships with citywide and community-based organizations. Internationals Network remains the only school development and support organization specifically addressing the educational needs of this disadvantaged recent immigrant and refugee population.

Internationals Network transforms education for immigrant and refugee multilingual learners by helping schools and districts better serve those students. Internationals designs new schools, coaches leaders, teachers, and school staff, and provides access to a collaborative, robust network of support and learning for those who work with us. Internationals Network schools are designed so that all school structures reinforce effective instructional practices for multilingual learners (MLLs), and build a positive school climate. The result is students that are far more successful than their counterparts outside of our network, graduating at much higher rates and thriving beyond high school. We have developed a comprehensive approach to the education of immigrant and refugee MLLs and broadened our impact by sharing proven best practices and influencing policy for MLLs. In the world of education reform, Internationals Network has become a leading voice in the education of immigrant and refugee multilingual learners across NYC and beyond.

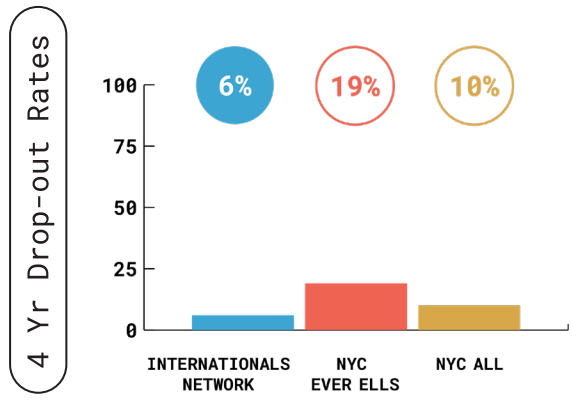
