- » Open-ended reflections by students about discussion.

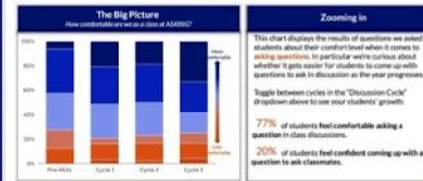
* Teachers may choose to share some or all of this data with their students. It's meant as a tool for you to dig deeper, get curious about patterns in your class, and grow your discussion practice.

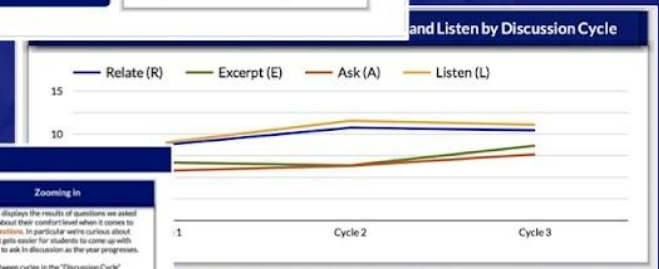
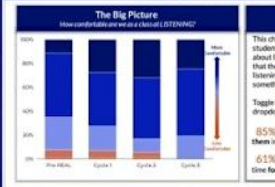
